

Press release regarding the forest fires in Chile

At Masisa we deeply regret the situation Chile is going through as a result of many wildfires and wish to report the following information.

- Masisa is currently dealing with forest fires in the Maule and Bío Bío (the 7th and 8th) regions, which are being fought by our company's fire brigades using the air, land and other support resources intended for such emergencies. The area affected measures some 375 hectares and the losses resulting from the fires amount to around US\$710,000.
- Masisa has fire insurance to cover its forestry heritage in Chile.
- Because of the scale of the fires, the emergency plan for such situations is in force. This considers all of Masisa's internal resources and support from third parties. At Masisa we have also been keeping informed about and providing whatever support we can with regard to other fires that are affecting the homes and property of other people outside of our land.
- During this whole process, Masisa has strengthened the safety measures for our employees. We are giving the highest priority to caring for our fire personnel who are fighting the fires.
- Our industrial operations in the Bío Bío region are operating normally, despite the difficulties on the roads resulting from the fires.
